

Occupational / Work Health & Safety Policy

The health and safety of those who work directly or indirectly for Clean Spark Facility Services is of the utmost importance to senior management and it is our goal to continually improve Occupational / Work, Health and Safety (OHS/WHS) performance within the business.

The key principles underpinning our policy are:

- Take health and safety issues seriously at a senior management level

We maintain and continuously improve a management system that complies with the requirements of ISO 45001:2018 and all OHS/WHS legislation and other requirements which are relevant to Clean Spark Facility Services.

Our OHS/WHS objectives are to:

- Have zero OHS/WHS incidents or accidents
- Ensure that OHS/WHS hazards are identified, assessed and controlled as much as practically possible

To achieve these objectives, we shall act to:

- Ensure a commitment to the participation of all workers
- Ensure a commitment to eliminate hazards (where possible) or reduce risks (as much as possible)
- Communicate this policy to all existing employees and to new employees upon commencement
- Complying with all OHS/WHS legislation and other requirements which are relevant to the company
- Making our commitment to health and safety visible to all interested parties
- Setting measurable objectives and targets which will be monitored to ensure continual improvement

This policy is applicable to all personnel in Clean Spark Facility Services, including any vendors working on behalf of the company. Together with the measurable objectives and targets, the policy will be reviewed on an annual basis to ensure that it remains relevant and suitable to business operations.
